

Episcopal Community Services Mission Statement

ECS helps homeless and very low-income people every day and every night obtain the housing, jobs, shelter, and essential services each person needs to prevent and end homelessness.

In the past year Episcopal Community Services provided:

- ▶ **A hot meal and a warm bed for 500 people each night at the Sanctuary, Next Door and the Winter Interfaith Shelters**
- ▶ **A permanent home for 1,000 people through our 11 supportive housing sites which includes on site social services**
- ▶ **Academic classes and vocational training, including our CHEFS program, for 842 people through ECS's Skills Center**
- ▶ **Programs for the elderly to help them find and keep housing through Canon Kip Senior Center**

Encouraging Success

ECS's SKILLS CENTER, in collaboration with the after school teen program at Canon Barcus Community House and with the support of the Miranda Lux Foundation, has developed a Youth Internship Program to help Canon Barcus teens gain useful pre-vocational experience prior to finishing high school. Students accepted into the program are placed in either community settings or at an ECS program site.

Yvette Burnside, Employment Specialist at Canon Barcus Community House, is excited that the teens are gaining potential work references and hopes to be able to continue this invaluable program beyond its one-year funding. "This program is getting these kids a head start by giving them real world experience before high school is over."

Joseph, who is 15 years old, is in the ZeumMasters Internship Program for Teens. His favorite part is working in the music video section. In fact, Joseph likes working with video so much that he has also been accepted to the Bay Area Video Coalition Youth Program.

When asked about the Canon Barcus Youth Internship Program, Joseph says, "This is a great program. I've never really had an experience like this. I think this program is in place for us to learn and get experience for when we get older. Zeum is a really cool environment to work in. Everyone has a positive attitude."

Sustained by Hope

RALPH COOPER WAS HOMELESS, and wanted to get off General Assistance by getting a job cooking. He applied to the CHEFS Program, graduated, and has been involved in the program ever since. This year Ralph prepared meals for the ECS Winter Interfaith Shelter, a place he stayed about 4 or 5 years ago. He went above and beyond to give participants quality meals because he remembered what it was like to be homeless himself. Ralph has been living in the same SRO Hotel for over a year.

Ralph says, "The CHEFS program has prepared me really well. Before I had no ambition to do anything, and I didn't care. Now I have drive. I'm goal oriented. I know what I want to do. I have a plan for how to get there, and how long it's going to take. That's what ECS has given me."

A New Collaboration between ECS, the California Wellness Foundation and Samuel Merritt College

TOGETHER WITH THE Samuel Merritt College and the California Wellness Foundation, ECS is piloting a new health education program so that our supportive housing site tenants can increase their health knowledge and learn to manage their own chronic conditions and disabilities.

Ten Samuel Merritt College nursing students spend one day a week doing personal health assessments, workshops, and health fairs for tenants at five ECS housing sites (The Le Nain, The Rose, Canon Kip, Canon Barcus, and the Pacific Bay Inn.) They provide essential one-on-one care, awareness, and prevention to those with complex medical needs and little health education. They give tenants valuable information about nutrition, personal hygiene, and they also provide hands-on education, like field trips to the farmers market to learn more about healthy food.

The California Wellness Foundation's grant complements this program by underwriting ECS's costs in hosting the nursing students' field education and by providing two funds to help with unmet expenses. The first fund pays transportation costs associated with medical appointments and the second fund helps to pay for any out-of-pocket costs for medications or medical equipment.

Both Samuel Merritt College and ECS hope to double the number of students doing their Community Health Course Internships at ECS housing sites, as it is an eye-opening field experience for students, and extremely beneficial to the supportive housing tenants. They are empowered by increased knowledge about their own health needs, and the students are blessed with the opportunity to help others improve their health and quality of life.

Network of Care

WHEN A NINETY-TWO year old woman suffering from occasional memory loss and mental illness, without money, friends or family, is evicted from her apartment, where does she go? If she's lucky she'll find a shelter, but if not, she may end up on the street. But neither setting is optimal for the frail elderly who may need assistance with daily tasks.

Through the new Assertive Case Management Program for Homeless Seniors at ECS's Canon Kip Senior Center, Ted Demissé actively searches for seniors ages 60 and above in shelters and other places where homeless people gather, and offers them intensive support to find permanent housing. As a case manager, Ted is vitally aware of the complex issues and challenges surrounding an elderly homeless person while advocating for their quality of life. "We want to make sure that clients who find housing are able to keep that housing," states Ted.

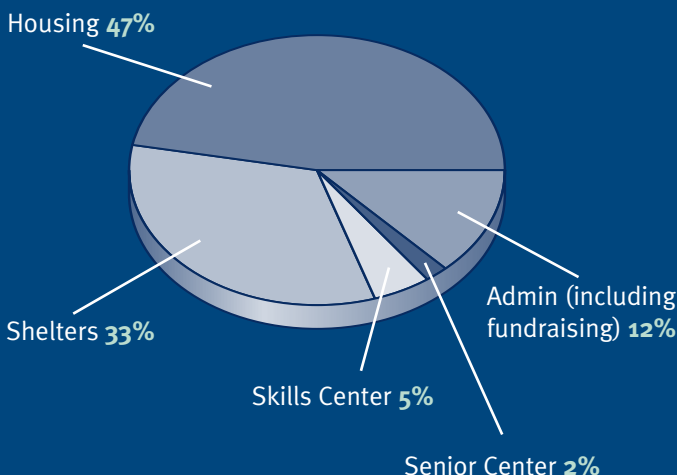
This proactive program focuses on creating a strong network of care. Case conferences — where case managers, social workers, shelter managers, and other professionals meet to focus on the needs of a single client — are an effective way to house challenging clients with success. Although the Assertive Case Management Program was only created a few months ago, there is already a caseload of more than 70 people.
