Coliseum Place: in Oakland will accommodate 59 one, two and three bedroom units. In the early stages of design, we are studying the potential for net zero energy consumption, with onsite production equal to the expected energy use.

Stargell Commons: will provide 32 apartment homes at Alameda Landing. Developed in partnership with Alameda Housing Authority, construction began in late 2015.

Riviera Family Apartments: will provide 58 affordable apartment homes close to downtown Walnut Creek and the BART station. The two buildings on two sites include eight studios, 24 one-bedroom units, seven two-bedroom units, and 18 three-bedroom units, plus a manager's unit. Construction starts in 2016.

Embark Apartments: in Oakland will provide approximately 65 new affordable apartments for veterans. On the ground floor will be management offices and a large multipurpose community room next to a parking garage, with apartments above.

Grayson Street Apartments: at 2748 San Pablo Avenue Berkeley CA will provide 23 one and two-bedroom apartments, including one manager's unit.
